

## Projects implemented in 2008-2016 within the framework of cooperation with German Government and European Union

### Promotion of Social Infrastructure Development' project

In the framework of the overall Ukrainian-German cooperation, USIF ensured implementation of the **'Promotion of Social Infrastructure Development' project**.

**Legal basis:** Framework Intergovernmental Agreement on consultancy and technical co-operation (signed 29.05.1996), Intergovernmental Agreement on financial co-operation (signed 27.12.2006), Financing and Project Agreements between the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine, KfW and USIF.

**Donor:** The Government of the Federal Republic of Germany through the Federal Ministry for Economic Cooperation and Development of Germany (BMZ) and German Bank for Development (KfW).

**Recipient:** Ministry of Social Policy of Ukraine.

#### Project goals:

- renovation and improvement of social infrastructure;
- strengthening of local communities' capacities

Since 2008 and until 2016 four grants for implementation of the Project in different regions of Ukraine for a total amount of 24.1 million euros were received. Those funds were invested in about 400 social infrastructure objects and in community development activities.



### 2008-2010

In June 2008 USIF and KfW launched their cooperation within the framework of the 'Promotion of Social Infrastructure Development' project in **Luhansk and Donetsk regions**. The budget of the project, ended in July 2010, was **7,7 mln. euros**, including 0,7 mln. euros of local communities' contributions. **160 subprojects** in 25 districts of Donetsk and Luhansk regions of Ukraine were implemented. 75 schools, 24 kindergartens, 31 water pipes, 10 cultural buildings, 18 primary care facilities, 1 sewerage network and 1 road were renovated. 270 thousand people benefited from the Project implementation.



### 2009-2013

The Project was implemented in **Autonomous Republic of Crimea**. The budget of the project, ended in 2013, was **8,9 mln. euros**, including 0,8 mln. euros of local communities' contributions.

**123 subprojects** in 12 districts of Autonomous Republic of Crimea were implemented. 50 schools, 19 kindergartens, 42 water pipes, 6 cultural buildings, 4 primary medical care facilities and 2 roads were renovated. 170 thousand people benefited from the implementation of those subprojects.



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## 2011-2013

The Project was implemented in **Kyiv** and **Lviv**. The budget of the project was 2,1 mln. euros, including 0,1 mln. of the local communities' contributions.

**18 subprojects** were implemented. 16 sports halls in secondary schools and 2 objects of social protection (geriatric boarding house in Lviv and orphanage in Kyiv) were renovated. 40 thousand people benefited from the Project implementation.



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## 2013-2016

The Project was implemented in **Vinnitsia**, **Kirovohrad** and **Lviv** regions.

The budget of the project was **8,395 mln. euros**, including 1,395 mln. euros of the local communities' contributions.

**93 subprojects** in 11 districts of Vinnitsia region, 8 districts of Kirovohrad region and 9 districts of Lviv region were implemented.

45 schools, 25 kindergartens, 11 water pipes, 6 primary medical care facilities, 4 cultural buildings and 2 libraries have been renovated. 90 thousand people benefited from the Project implementation.

## Support to the Joint Cooperation Initiative in Crimea. Component 2 – Social Infrastructures

**Donor:** European Union (provided through KfW)

**Implementation period:** 2013 – 2014.

**Geography:** Autonomous Republic of Crimea.

**Main results:** 43 social objects, including 25 schools, 15 kindergartens and 3 water pipes, were renovated.

23 thousand people benefited from the Project implementation.

1,6 mln. of EU grant funds were utilized.
