

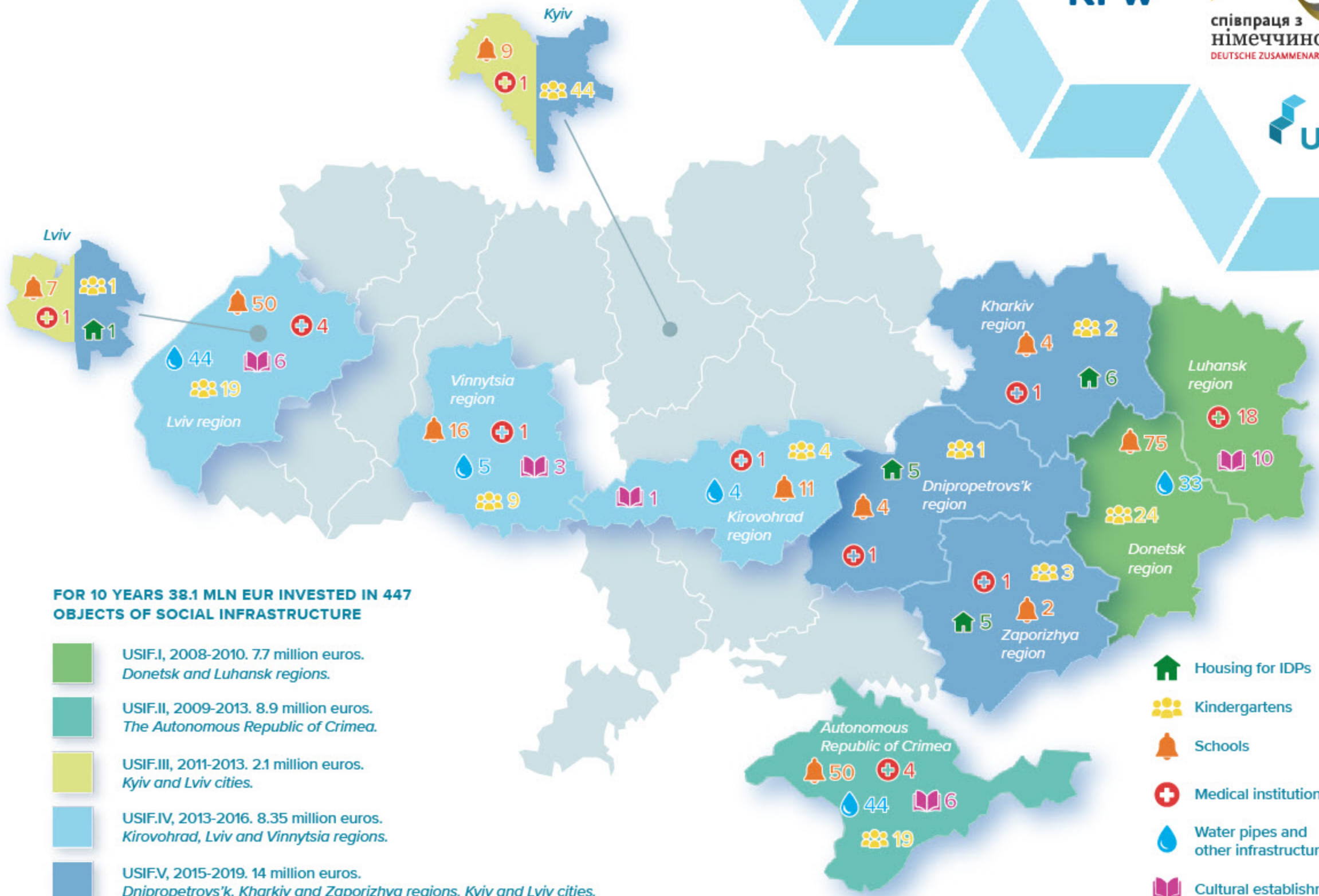

GERMANY INCREASES FINANCIAL SUPPORT FOR UKRAINE

2018-2023

At the end of 2018, a new phase of the “Promotion of Social Infrastructure Development” project will be launched. Grant funds are to be channeled into Dnipropetrovs’k, Kharkiv, Zaporizhya regions and some districts of Donetsk and Luhansk regions, which are under control of Ukraine. It is envisaged to provide internally displaced persons (IDPs) with social housing and renovate social infrastructure facilities (schools and kindergartens) under this project. The sum of the grant funds, allocated by the German Government for USIF.VI project, is 9 million euros. The new project will help about 750 IDPs to get social housing. About 15 schools and kindergartens will be renovated in the course of USIF.VI implementation as well.

The implementation of the next new phase, “Promotion of Social Infrastructure Development. USIF.VII” project, is expected to be launched in 2019 in Dnipropetrovs’k, Kharkiv, Zaporizhya regions and in some districts of Donetsk and Luhansk regions, which are under control of Ukraine. The grant funds of the German Government totaling 14.45 million euros will help to renovate and equip with modern medical devices at least 35-40 primary healthcare centers.
